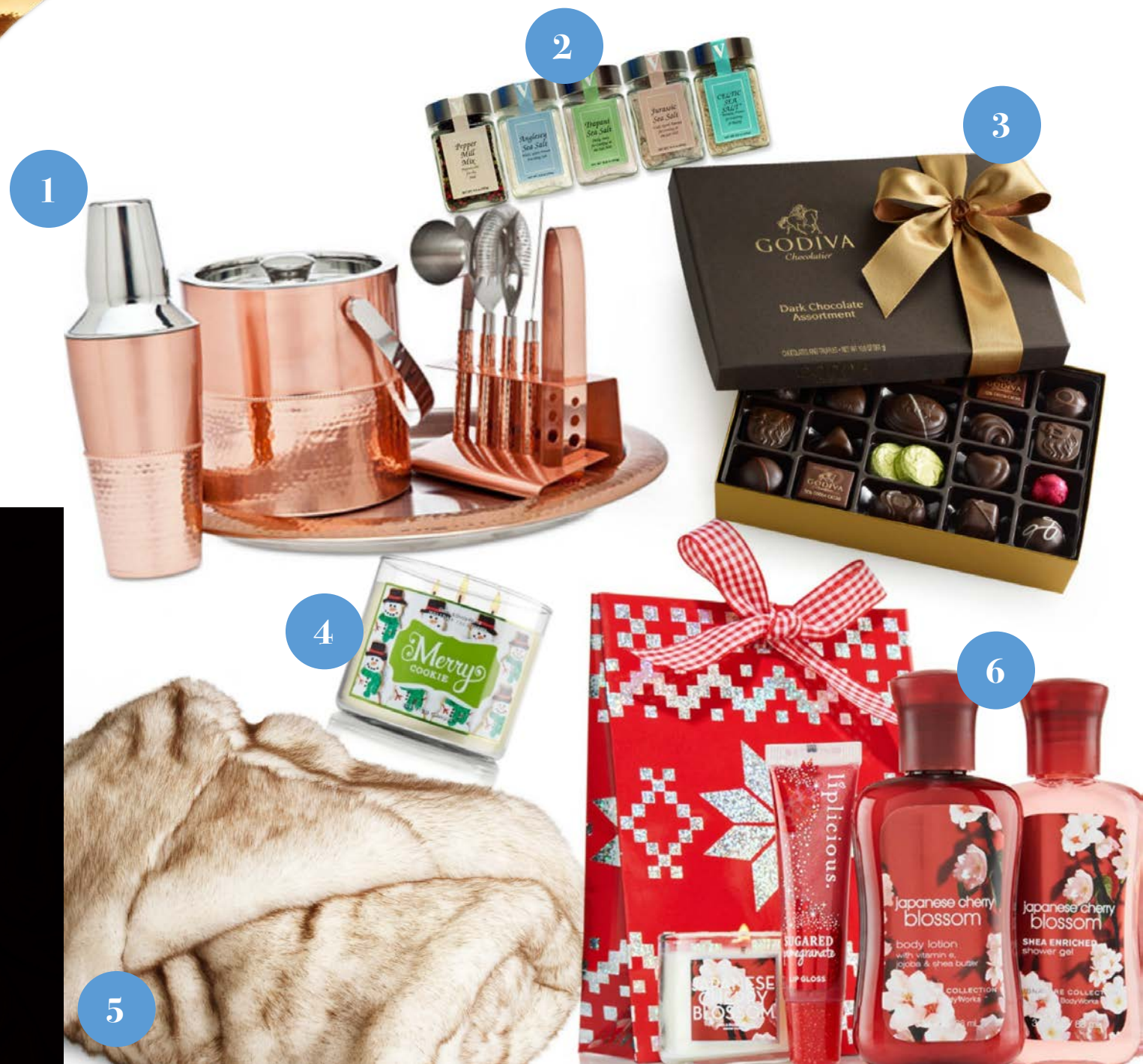

Home-cooked taste doesn't have to start at home. Families are taking a well-deserved break from cooking to feast on comfort food cravings at their favorite restaurants.



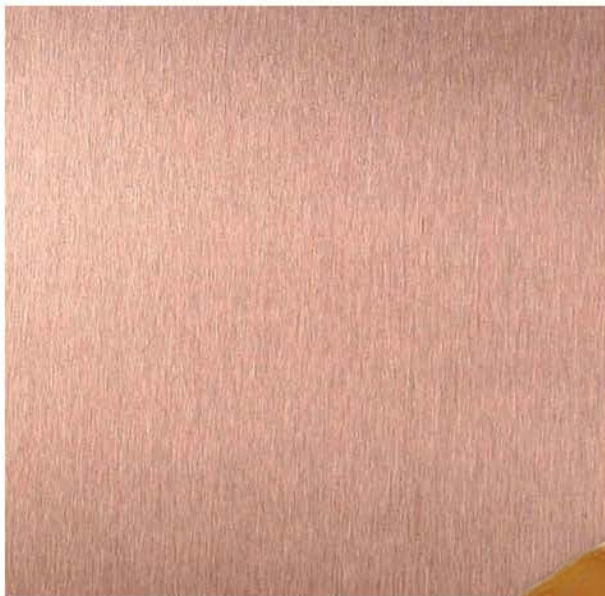
