

Know your tequila

How much to you really know about this lively spirit? Tequila is distilled from the sugar-rich juice of the blue agave—a spikey plant harvested in the Mexican state of Jalisco. By law, tequila can only be produced in just five Mexican states (so enjoy every sip). Your first rule of thumb: Buy a bottle with a “100% agave label” for the best quality & taste. Now grab a lime & find the right tequila for your next get-together.



Blanco

"WHITE OR SILVER" TEQUILA

This is tequila in its purest form. The fresh, clear-colored tequila is bottled or stored directly after distillation. No aging or mixing here—just the natural (often intense) taste of pure agave.

Other Mezcal

Mezcal is an alcohol that's distilled in northern Mexico from any type of agave plant. Don't just stick to tequila (and the blue agave), expand your horizons if you're feeling adventurous.

Reposado

"RESTED" TEQUILA

Aged in oak barrels for up to a year, this golden-hued tequila balances warm flavors of agave, honey, caramel & natural wood. It's more mellow than blanco tequila & perfect for your next margarita or mixed drink.

Añejo

"AGED" TEQUILA

This true “sipping” tequila is the senior of the bunch (aged 1–3 years) with a rich, amber color. The extended aging process makes añejo tequila a smooth choice if you enjoy more complex flavors.
